 - Integrate technology, workplace competencies, and Indian Education for All
 - Update pertinent documents on Co-op website
 - Plan for sharing of updates at individual district level

- Provide support and suggested professional development for standards and materials adoption
 - Offer professional development to support standards, lesson design, and best practices
 - Support teachers & leadership with new standards
 - Support teachers & leadership with supervision and program analysis
- Finish @ the District Level:**
- Communicate changes to relevant district stake holders (as per policy)
 - Review, evaluate, and make suggestions for resource adoption (per district policy)
 - Check for alignment with district and state assessments
 - Develop reporting systems for progress towards mastery of grade level expectations
 - Ensure implementation of standards at building and district levels
